



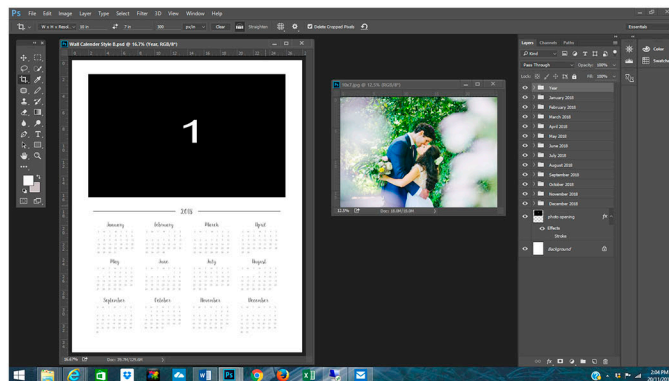
# Wall Calendar

## DESIGN GUIDE

Using our Wall Calendar Photoshop templates make designing your calendar easy! All templates are fully layered PSD (Photoshop) files which allow you to add and edit photos, text and colours as well as adding your studio logo. Please remember to flatten your Photoshop files to jpegs before sending your completed template to Seldex.

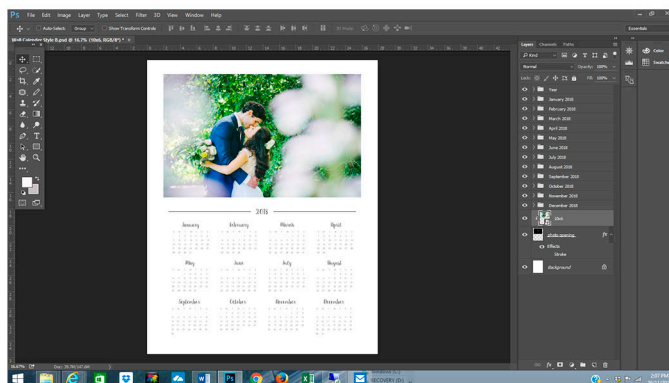
### HOW TO USE YOUR TEMPLATE

1. Open your chosen template in Photoshop, then open your image in Photoshop. We print at 300 dpi and your template has been set to reflect this. There is no need for you to crop your images prior to importing them into Photoshop or inserting them into the template.



2. Using the move tool, drag the photograph onto the template and position it above the photo opening layer, in the layers tool bar, in which you want it to display - as shown in the screenshot below.

3. To insert the photo behind the mask press Control+Alt+G. The photo will insert into the opening and will "clip" (hide) any part of the photo that goes beyond the opening. For Mac users you will need to press Command+Option+G.



4. Once your photo has been inserted behind the mask it is ready to resize. Ensure the photograph layer is highlighted. Utilise the Free Transform function, Control T (or Command+T for Mac users) and resize your image. Make sure to hold down the shift key to keep your proportions even while you drag a corner to adjust the size of the photo. Use the Move tool to position it correctly behind the opening.

5. When your order is ready to send to us please remember to flatten the layers and save it as a jpeg.
